NGEE ANN POLYTECHNIC A PLAYGROUND FOR STARTUPS

Smart eating places, digital certificates and intelligent mentor matching among smart initiatives to transform campus

Singapore, 23 May 2017 – Makan and milo without taking out your wallet. That's a mealtime that Ngee Ann Polytechnic (NP) students now enjoy.

In line with the national push towards a Smart Nation, the polytechnic is embracing technology designed to enrich living and learning on campus. NP started Campus Ecosystem, a programme that aims to have 100 startups. Since its inception in March this year, 12 startups have come on board. The programme focuses on four areas of innovation – Student Life, Teaching & Learning, Work Culture, and Work Processes. NP is also partnering several startups to introduce the digitalisation of campus food spots and career management services for its 15,000 student population.

NP is working with United Overseas Bank (UOB) and its network of customers and strategic partners like LiquidPay for a cashless payment system, and Attores to issue digital certificates to authenticate a student's qualification quickly and easily. NP is also working with CISCO, GLINTS, Green Koncepts, Protégé and SingTel on several campus solutions.

On the importance of working with startups to create a future-ready campus, NP's Principal, Clarence Ti, said: "We're excited that NP can act as a test bed for these new innovations. The startups we work with aim to deeply enhance students' and staff's campus experience, in and out of class. As we've seen, the changes don't have to be drastic. Often, little conveniences have the greatest impact."

Ms Janet Young, Head of Group Channels and Digitalisation, UOB, said, "Many organisations are looking to use technology to improve their operations, and the right business partner for their specific needs. We believe that through our network of customers and FinTech partnerships, we can connect organisations to the best partner to help them achieve their digitalisation objectives. Whether it is being able to spend less time queueing up and more time enjoying a meal or applying for their next course

or first job with ease, we hope that these initiatives will help enhance the experience for NP's students."

Eat Smart

For starters, students and staff are now able to purchase meals without the need for cash. NP is piloting the move to cashless canteens starting with one of its canteens, Munch. Through LiquidPay's technology, students and staff can create and top up e-wallets with their existing banking cards. Payment may be made by snapping a shot of the QR code placed at each counter.

The NP population can also enjoy another cashless system under SingTel's Dash app. All they need to do is conveniently tap and pay¹ for their meals with the app that supports in-store and online retail payments, as well as transit payments. Singtel Dash accounts can be topped up via eNets, Singtel bill or at AXS and 7-Eleven outlets.

Additionally, a new Smart Crowd Sensing technology by CISCO and GreenKoncepts now leverages Wi-Fi to estimate how crowded the canteens are. Using an online dashboard with informative graphics and user-friendly tags such as "Comfy", "Busy" and "Crowded", students get an overview of the crowd across all four canteens on the go via NP's mobile student app.

Learn Smart

NP students will get digital certificates to speed up their career and university applications. NP is working with UOB FinLab's blockchain startup, Attores, to deploy its Diploma Plus Certificates directly to the students' LinkedIn profiles. This is a first among the local polytechnics.

The technology makes it easy for prospective employers or university admissions office to validate the authenticity of the certificate. If the pilot is successful, the plan is to extend it to all of NP's Diploma Certificates, accessible via a blockchain browser online.

Match Smart

NP students can match with industry mentors online. This convenience is all thanks to a pilot project with Protégé, which has developed a mentoring app to help students under NP's Industry Mentors Network programme.

The app gradually builds up a mentor's profile by getting to know them better, facilitating mentor-mentee matching based on learning outcomes and chemistry fit. It also tracks

the engagements between them for constant feedback on the progress of the relationship.

Other smart career management initiatives include NP@GLINTS platform which enable students to source and curate a customised internship preference for multiple internships.
